The aim of EMSEP

- To provide high-quality research-oriented master's-level education, through English, in the multidisciplinary field of Sport and Exercise Psychology

EMSEP Characteristics

- EMSEP programme offers educational opportunities for students of all nationalities
- The two-year full-time programme consists of 120 ECTS credits
- The students will study in at least two universities during their studies

Admission requirements

- Previous studies: Bachelor's degree with good grades in Sport Sciences, Psychology, Social Psychology or other relevant field
- Proof of English language proficiency
- Proven interest in the field of Sport and Exercise Psychology
- Basic knowledge of research methodology

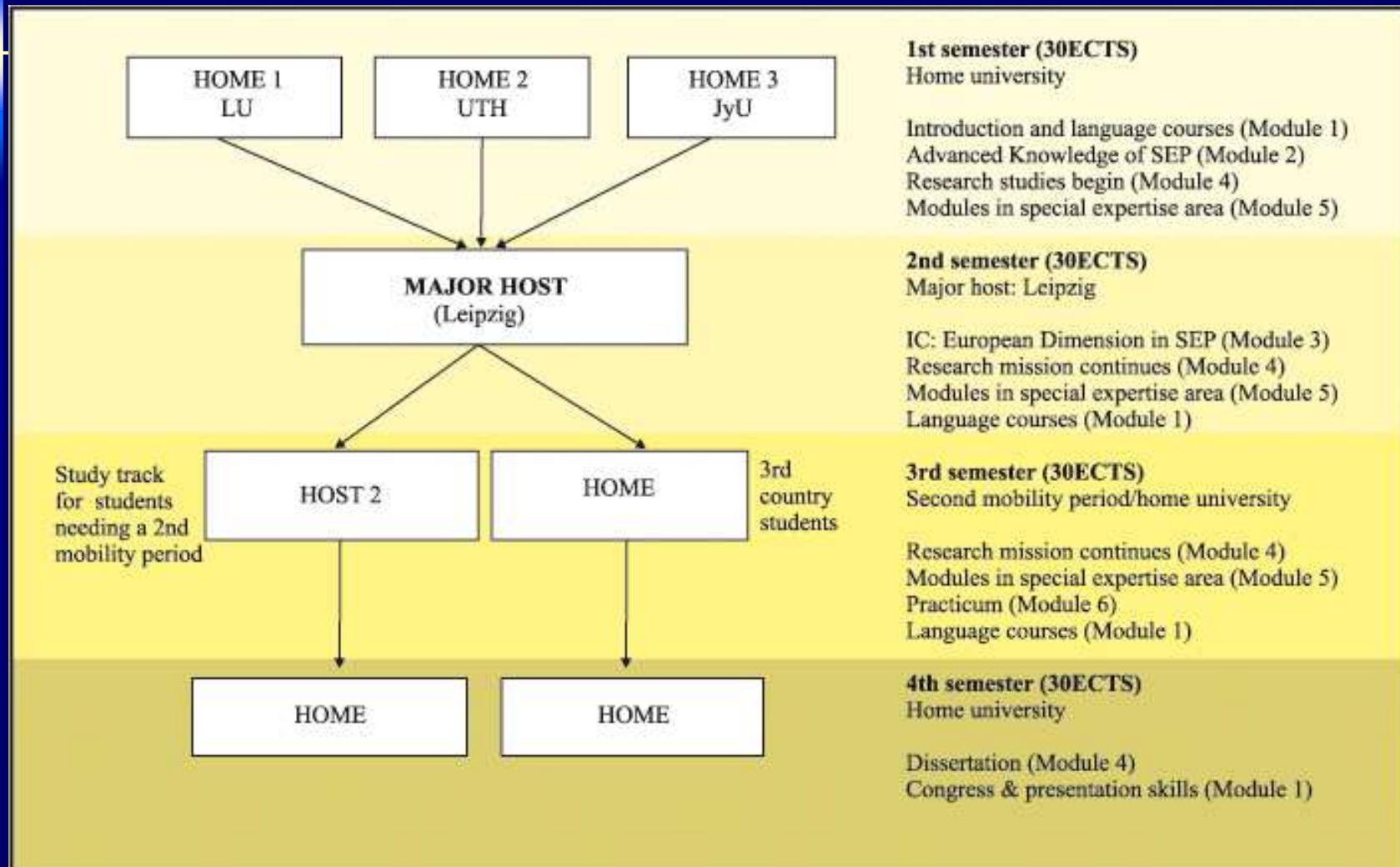
Erasmus Mundus is...

- Cooperation programme
 - Four universities organise the programme jointly: Jyväskylä, Finland (coordinator); Lund, Sweden; Thessaly, Greece; and Leipzig, Germany
 - The programme graduates will receive a double degree (master's degree from two universities/countries)

...Scholarship programme

- Generous scholarships are awarded for both European and non-European students on a competitive basis
- Scholarships cover:
 - tuition fees
 - health insurance
 - support for living expenses
- In addition, non-European students receive support also for traveling expenses
- In total, the scholarship amounts to € 47 000 for non-European students and € 20 000 for European students during the two years of study
- Scholarships are also available for experienced non-European scholars who participate in teaching at the EMSEP programme

...Mobility programme



The EMSEP provides the student with:

- Research-based, interdisciplinary and high-quality teaching from leading experts in Europe
- An individualised study plan
- Hands-on experience in the field during the practicum period
- Experience of a truly international study environment, including a study abroad period at another partner university and networking with fellow students and experts
- Officially recognised double degree from two network universities
- A possible scholarship for the studies
